Dr Faye Gishen Biography

Faye Gishen is a clinical academic. She is a consultant physician in palliative medicine, and an undergraduate medical educator. Her clinical practice is mainly in the outpatient setting where, as well as seeing 'classical' palliative care patients, she also has a cancer survivorship practice, with an emphasis on rehabilitation and symptom control. She is the academic lead for Clinical and Professional Practice, which makes up 20% of the University College London Medical School curriculum.

Faye has introduced reflective practice Schwartz Rounds into both her clinical workplace and the UCL curriculum, for which she received a UCL Provost Teaching Award in 2016. She will be facilitating a Schwartz Round at the RCP Innovation conference.
