Following a 35 year career in theatre and feature film production Iona became interested in patient advocacy after caring for her parents during their final years and following her own period of ill health. She decided to use her experience as both a patient and carer, to lobby for improvement to services.

In 2014 Iona became a member of the Royal College of Physicians Patient and Carer network. Iona was a member of the RCP's Committee on Ethical Issues in Medicine for three years. In 2015 she joined the Fracture Liaison Service and National Hip Fracture audit advisory teams as a patient representative. In 2018 the Falls and Fragility Fracture Audit Programme Patient Panel was established and Iona is currently the Interim Chair.
